New Testament miracles were a fulfillment of prophecy and a demonstration of divine power. These miracles helped Christianity achieve rapid growth despite a period of persecution. They removed all doubt from the disciples minds and created an unshakable faith among them. *If God is for us, who can be against us?* (Ro 8:31).

Yet Jesus' earthly miracles were not enough to begin Christianity. The disciples abandoned Jesus at the crucifixion (fulfilling prophecy). It was the resurrection (and giving of the Holy Spirit) that emboldened the early disciples to spread the "good news" throughout the world (beginning at Jerusalem): Jesus is our risen Lord and Savior!
