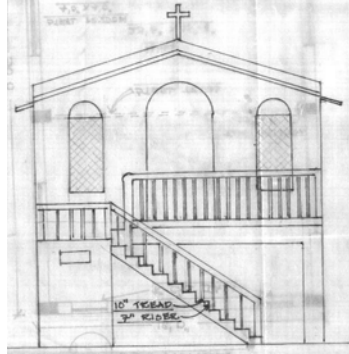

## The Original Apostles

**Simon-Peter:** married, Andrew's brother, fisherman, from Bethsaida, walked on water with Jesus, witnessed Jesus' transfiguration, denied Jesus three times, was visited by the risen Lord, became the leader of the apostles after Jesus' ascension, healed the sick and raised the dead, wrote Peter 1 and Peter 2 in the New Testament, crucified upside down in 64 A..D.

**James son of Zebedee:** older brother of John, fisherman, one of the first called by Jesus, witnessed Jesus' transfiguration, beheaded by King Herod 44 A..D.

**Simon the Zealot:** member of the violence-prone Zealite Party, cast out unclean spirits and healed the sick, crucified.

**John:** brother of James, fisherman, wrote John, 1 John, 2 John, 3 John and Revelation, only disciple not put to death, exiled to Patmos.

**Andrew:** brother of Simon Peter, fisherman from Bethsaida, former disciple of John the Baptist, crucified.

**Philip:** from Bethsaida, converted an Ethiopian eunuch, worked miracles in Samaria, crucified.

**Thomas-Didymus:** wanted visual proof of the resurrection, speared.

**Matthew:** tax collector, wrote Matthew, speared.

**Judas Iscariot:** betrayed Jesus, hung himself.

**James son of Alphaeus:** stoned to death.

**Thaddaeus-Judas:** stoned to death.

**Bartholomew:** crucified.
